

New Patient Treatment Agreement

Your companion animal is about to begin homeopathic veterinary treatment. As you probably already realize, many of the recommendations you will receive during this treatment are different from that which other veterinarians have previously made. Fresh diet (including the Bones And Raw Food diet), nutritional supplementation and homeopathic stimulation of natural healing will be emphasized rather than drug therapy or surgery. I feel that these are the most effective ways of dealing with most of the health problems faced by our companion animals (and us!).

Not every problem can be successfully treated in this way however. Many clients come to HomeVet® because conventional veterinary medicine has left them without hope. These are usually very serious diseases which may be far too advanced for even these (or any) methods. Occasionally a patient is not able to respond to holistic therapies despite an ostensibly early disease. I do not say this to discourage you, but rather in the name of open and honest communications.

It is important, as we start working together that you realize that regardless of your companion's problem I am going to use only the methods that I feel are indicated in his or her treatment. If you decide to have conventional drug therapy or surgery I may refer you to a specialist who can provide this service. If it is my opinion that for the well-being of your companion that you should receive care from another practitioner or by other methods I will also refer you.

Due to the nature of my practice and the amount of time I must dedicate to each case, it is impossible for me to handle more than a limited number of emergencies. You should not expect me to be available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. I only accept a limited number of patients and try to give them very personalized attention. In the event of a life-threatening emergency, if I can not be reached in a timely fashion, you should use a local emergency service.
